Following feedback from our Learning Council, it became clear that many children struggled to recall our previous school rules. While our vision of "Life in all its Fullness" remains at the heart of everything we do, and our core values—*Believing, Being Our Best, Being Creative, and Belonging*—continue to shape our school culture, we wanted to simplify our rules so they are easy to understand and follow.

This week in Collective Worship, we introduced our new school rules: **Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe**. The children have already embraced them enthusiastically!

- **Be Ready:** This means being prepared to listen, arriving on time, wearing the correct uniform, and having the right equipment.
- **Be Respectful:** We show respect by listening to others, valuing different cultures and beliefs, understanding that everyone is unique but share the same emotions, and following the laws of society.
- **Be Safe:** We keep ourselves and others safe by moving sensibly around school, following instructions, using equipment properly, reporting concerns to an adult, and staying safe online.

We believe these simple, clear rules will help all children to thrive and truly *Be Their Best!*
